

Grove Park Swimming Pool Rules and Regulations

Grove Park HOA, Inc.

Trespassers should be reported to ACWORTH CITY POLICE at 770-974-3111 for local dispatch or simply call 911!

If police or fire department assistance is needed dial 911 immediately with the location of 4463 Grove Drive, Acworth, 30101.

1. Pool privileges may be revoke if pool rules are not obeyed. Be prepared to show gate key to any member of the Board and/or the pool attendant. All members and their guests are required to sign in upon entering the pool area. If your key does not work please contact Carter Realty, Inc., at (770) 924-9009.
2. Any member not in good standing with the association or not current with fees may not use the facilities or be a guest of a member. If you key notes not work it may have been de-activated for non-payment of dues/fines, a rule or regulation violation, or it may be a damaged card. Members in the facility may not let other members whose key does not work into the facility. Members who do this may be subject to having their own key de-activated! Please contact Carter Realty, Inc. at (770) 924-9009 or the Board if you see this occurring.
3. **The following are not permitted in the amenities area: Fighting, disorderly conduct, vandalism, running, jumping, and boisterous conduct, abusive or profane language.** Any person violating these standards will be asked to immediately leave the amenities area. Persons who not leave after being asked to do so will be considered trespassers and the authorities will be called.
4. All guests (limited to 6 in the pool area) must be accompanied at all times by their adult host member (except to out-of-town guests staying with a member). The facilities may not be closed for private parties.
5. **Children 12 and under must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.** Parents/legal guardian assumes all responsibility and releases the association for liability for children of any age.
6. The following are prohibited in the fenced area of the pool: glass, breakable containers, bicycles, skates, skateboards, dangerous toys, running, horseplay, and acrobatics. Pets are not permitted. Grills, cooking, and hot containers are not permitted on the community property/amenities area.
7. Personal items (chairs, floats, etc.) must be removed when leaving the amenities area.
8. Rubber swim pants are required to be worn by all babies and un-potty trained children.
9. Only proper swimming attire may be worn in the pool. **NO JEANS, JEAN SHORTS, BOXERS, CUTOFFS, ETC.**
10. Oversized floats are prohibited. All floats are prohibited when the pool is crowded.
11. **ALL SWIMMING IS AT YOUR OWN RISK. NO DIVING ALLOWED!**
12. All alcoholic beverages of any kind are prohibited in the amenities area. No intoxicated persons are permitted in the amenities area.
13. Noise should be kept at a reasonable level, as determined by the Board, so as to not interfere with the enjoyment of others.
14. Smoking is prohibited in **ALL** amenities area!
15. Posted signs are to be observed and obeyed by **ALL**.
16. Pool parties require prior approval from the HOA Board. The homeowner throwing the party is required to hire an additional lifeguard at their own expense. Contact Sweetwater Pool Management at (678) 727-7665 to hire a lifeguard after you have the approval from the Board.

MONETARY FINES AND/OR POOL/TENNIS RESTRICTIONS AND DEACTIVATION OF AMENITIES KEY MAY BE IMPOSED FOR NON-COMPLIANCE WITH THESE RULES. THE HOMEOWNER/MEMBER PERSONALLY ASSUMES FULL LIABILITY FOR ANY LITIGATION CAUSED BY THE HOMEOWNER/MEMBER (OR FAMILY MEMBER OR GUEST) NOT COMPLYING WITH THE ABOVE RULES.
